Dear friends,

Once again a year is nearing its end, once again it is harvest time....; a very rich year this time. We haven't had so many apples, pears, plums in a long time.... We had to support our trees in the yard, so they wouldn't break under their load.

I rejoiced hearing the news from Israel, where they are celebrating the feast of tabernacles at this time, the "Nations entering" the people of God. Yes, God is still harvesting, so that Jesus may return.

The question is: Are we in the ripe fields? Or have we grown tired?

Last Friday we attended an interesting wedding: The bridegroom (38 years), pastor of a lively church for the last 10 years, the bride (21 years), a devoted co-worker in the children ministry. "They got to know each other like Boas and Ruth harvesting the fields", said the pastor performing the ceremony.

<u>As a family</u>: We are doing well, praise God. It has been much easier for **Michael** to bring in the hay, thanks to his good machines. **Senta** was able to can loads of plum puree, apple and pear jam thanks to the help of our new co-workers Attila and Theodora.

Philippus is looking forward to "his new school", a day care center for adults with disabilities that is going to open in October.

<u>As a church</u>: We are experiencing a little "awakening". After a sad time, when several co-workers left due to the retreat of Stefan and Mikaela, who had served as pastors with us for 3 years, God has surprised us several times:

Our cooperation with Rolf and Elisabeth from Dietmannsried, who were mainly involved in social work until now, has grown much closer. Rolf is helping to preach and Elisabeth is very involved in the children ministry – which is a huge blessing to us. Through their work at the "Combinat" – a district on the edges of Fagaras with very poor families, several of them have opened to the gospel and are attending church.
A new couple, (Attila and Theodora) moved to live with us to support us in the youth ministry. He is a trained psychologist and both their hearts beat to reach the young generation – maybe even to open a day care center for young people, where they can spend afternoons – to receive help for homework, but also for entertainment (pool, table tennis, etc.) Please pray for that!!!

- Some of the co-worker that left a year ago are slowly returning. Please pray for wisdom on how to approach them.

<u>Our teens and children</u> experienced two wonderful camps, thanks to the German teams, again. At the end of July the **young adults from Bramsche** served us and not only did they serve the young people through games and fun and personal testimonies, but they also formed a team to be trained as future leaders. We met with that team on several occasions in the mornings and talked about the meaning of "finding one's calling or talents and to let God use you within those". In the beginning of August the **Royal Rangers from Senden** led a children's camp. During that camp the "trained leader teens" were able to act as group leaders. In teams of two they were responsible for a girl's room or a boy's room. We all met in the mornings at 7am to pray and to organize the small groups that would meet during the day as well. It was a blessed time.

Our teens are looking forward to November 1st-3rd when they will be trained in discipleship by the Senden people again. We also meet regularly on Sunday afternoons to play Volleyball here in Scharosch and to learn to follow Jesus.

Please pray for breakthroughs - radical conversions among the teenagers!!!

Misch's allergy (Asthma) have been bothering and tiring him during work. Yesterday we found a good physician here in Fagaras = godly guidance and found out that we can buy his Symbicord medication, which he has to take twice a day here as well. Yet awe are praying for complete healing.

Philippus' pension has been extended through god's guidance and he is doing much better psychologically. He is much more balanced, sleeps well, has had no more epileptic seizures and learns to handle challenges (like being scared of loud people) much better. Please pray for him to settle well into his new day care.

Lidia our organist in worship has an autistic son, much worse than Philippus, is asking for prayer support as well. Firstly for her son Alex, who will be admitted to the daycare center together with Philippus at the beginning of October.

But also for herself, she is suffering from osteoporosis, hasn't been able to sleep due to pain in her joints and her back over the last nights. The doctors don't know how to help her, yet. Please pray for her to find the right doctor or for supernatural healing.

We would like to build two more rooms in the attic of the main house, because we had limited sleeping space during our summer camps this year. 12-14 boys had to sleep on mattresses on the attic's bare wood floor.
