People forget very quickly about the tragedy of over 3,000 people being smothered alive by the Volcano

Fuego tragedy back on 3 June 2018, and the Government has done nothing to help them. They have even lied about the numbers killed, but some missionaries are still working hard with the many displaced families who cannot ever return to their homes. This month we have purchased further food and clothes supplies and also bedding for a family with three children whom were found living under a tree with thin sheet of plastic as their roof (see photos above). At nighttime they just huddled together for warmth, as their bedding was the ground. All their washing was in a small polluted pond, and they used the same water which they heated up as drinking water! It is no wonder these people get sick and die. A friend of mine whom I work with has since found temporary accommodation for this family. But there are probably another 20 families just like them. We urgently need more funds to help these people who have nothing. If you wish to help, please send your donations marked "Volcano" to one of the addresses below. Thank you in advance.

Temporary Schooling for the Volcano Kids



Beatriz is a wonderful lady whom I work with to give help to the Volcano people. This past week she has set up a temporary school for the Volcano Kids and has 11 pupils. Three other ladies who are official teachers have given up their time to teach these kids free of charge for four days a week. A part of our funds have gone into purchasing books and stationery items. There are no funds to place these children into official schools and was the reason to start up the school. A missionary friend of mine told me a story that made me weep. He too, is working with the volcano kids. He is a teacher and has an official school close to the volcano Fuego that killed 30 of his schoolchildren. Somehow he has managed to start the school up again in temporary accommodation and has over 120 children being educated. He told me about one mother who at night worked as a prostitute to earn money to pay for her daughter's education. This is life

in Guatemala, and this probably goes on elsewhere. Meanwhile he has spoken with the mother, and she received help to pay for the education of her daughter.
